

## Implementation and Use of the Ultra Violet Waterworks Technology

The Ultra Violet Waterworks (UVW) technology, developed by the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), has been marketed by Waterhealth International Inc. (WII) to areas of the world needing clean water. WII has installed UV Waterworks systems in multiple countries, including [Mexico](#), the [Philippines](#), Bangladesh, South Africa and Honduras.

The UV Waterworks technology was also successfully used in the aftermath of [Hurricane Mitch](#), which occurred October 22 through November 4, 1998.
