## 8th Diesel Engine Emissions Reduction Workshop

The 8th Diesel Engine Emissions Reduction (DEER) Conference was held at the Loews Coronado Bay Resort in San Diego, California.

The Department of Energy (DOE), with support from other State and Federal agencies, established this series of Workshops to coordinate government and commercial efforts in reducing diesel engine emissions. The objective of this Workshop is to provide a forum for the Federal and State agency personnel involved with diesel engines as users, regula-

tors, or supporting research and development along with the diesel engine manufacturers, the national laboratories, academia, the environmentalists, and the health effects community. The first three Workshops were held biennially while the last five have been held annually due to the increasing level of interest in clean diesel engine technology.
