

Reference Linking Service Available at OSTI

The usefulness of electronic R&D reports, such as those presented through the DOE Information Bridge, is much enhanced if report references are accessible via hyperlinks. The Office of Scientific and Technical Information (OSTI) is giving authors the opportunity to have their reports enhanced through [DOE's Reference Linking service](#). At your request, DOE will identify hyperlinks for as many of your references as possible, and update the file accordingly. There is no charge to you or your organization for this service. OSTI also enables reference links to technical reports from journal articles. Specifically, OSTI works with [CrossRef](#) so that when a journal article includes a reference to a technical report, publishers of the journal article can include the hyperlink to the technical report. This service gives the readers the ability to simply click on the hyperlink of a reference at the end of a report, and the referenced material will be displayed on the user's computer screen.
