SUBJECT: DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY OPENNET

In the next few weeks the Department of Energy (DOE), Office of Declassification will achieve an exciting milestone with the public unveiling of OpenNet. We anticipate a significant level of interest from DOE stakeholders and the public. It is important that we be able to provide adequate information on where citizens in various parts of the country may access and use OpenNet.

We need your help to collect this information. Please provide the following information and forward it to DOE Headquarters, Office of Declassification. We need your preliminary information no later than close of business Wednesday, November 9, 1994, and your final data no later than November 16, 1994.

1. Is OpenNet accessible at your local site public reading room? If so, its location, hours, a point of contact and telephone number.
2. Is OpenNet accessible at any public library in your area? If so, their locations, hours, and phone number.

OpenNet is most impressive in its full Mosaic form, so please, first determine if Mosaic Internet access is available and, if not, then determine if Telenet (text only) Internet access is available.
