The Department of Energy (DOE) Research and Development (R&D) Accomplishments Web site is a publicly-available central forum for information about the outcomes of past DOE R&D. The outcomes featured have had significant economic impact, have improved people's lives, or have been widely recognized as a remarkable advance in science. An R&D accomplishment is the outcome of **past** research whose benefits are being realized now.

The Web site is comprised of the R&D Accomplishments Database, Featured Topics pages, and Snapshots. This exciting collection showcases the proud heritage of the Department's R&D.

R&D Accomplishments Database

Consists of searchable full text and bibliographic citations of documents reporting accomplishments from DOE and DOE contractor facilities. The Database was developed and is maintained and supported by the DOE Office of Scientific and Technical Information (OSTI).

Database Features

- Full-text search by word or phrase
- Browse by title listing of available reports
- Searchable PDF which highlights search terms in document
- Download full-text PDF files or as single-page images
- Best viewed with Netscape 4.0 and above, or Microsoft Explorer 4.0 and above

Featured Topics Pages

May spotlight an area of research or an individual scientist.

Pages highlighting areas of research provide summary information about the research and links to related full-text reports and Web pages.

Pages highlighting individuals provide insights into the scientist's body of research, a biographical sketch, recognitions, and links to related full-text reports and Web pages.



The Enrico Fermi page has been selected by the National Science Teachers Association

(NSTA) for inclusion in SciLinks, an innovative initiative that links science textbooks to the Internet. Inclusion in SciLinks is based on strict criteria and includes Web site identification by a cadre of Web spotters, evaluation by teacher-Webwatchers with expertise in the science field and grade levels, and approval by NSTA staff. In addition, Web sites chosen for SciLinks are correlated to National Science Education Standards.

Snapshots

Provide quick pictures, introductions, overviews, or synopses of DOE accomplishments. They contain links to items, articles, and reports that contain information about or identify at least one R&D accomplishment.
