DOE PAGES is the DOE response to the February 2013 White House Office of Science and Technology Policy memo tasking federal science agencies with increasing access to peer-reviewed scientific publications.

With **DOE PAGES**, DOE is

- offering readers the best available versions of DOE-affiliated scholarly publications, either the version-of-record journal articles or the corresponding accepted manuscripts;
- utilizing its established scientific and technical information infrastructure and systems to provide access to DOE-funded authors' accepted manuscripts; and
- partnering with the publisher consortium CHORUS – the Clearinghouse for the Open Research of the United States – and other organizations to complement DOE's public access model.

A cooperative and cost-effective approach to public access to scholarly scientific publications

DOE PAGES builds on the DOE Scientific and Technical Information Program and integrates publishers' public access efforts.

DOE PAGES is a hybrid public access model of both centralized and distributed content:

- Centralized metadata powers a robust search engine.
- Distributed full-text access is offered to articles or accepted manuscripts hosted by publishers and DOE-funded Labs and other institutions.

DOE PAGES contains nearly 50,000 journal articles and accepted manuscripts.

DOE PAGES offers full-text access to all DOE-affiliated accepted manuscripts or articles after a 12-month administrative interval.

DOE PAGES is scalable to accommodate the large number of DOE-affiliated scholarly scientific publications produced each year, with anticipated annual growth of 20,000-30,000 articles and accepted manuscripts.
