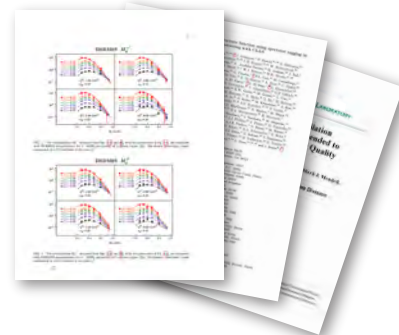

Public Access Milestones

February 2013: Office of Science and Technology Policy memo issued

OSTP directs federal agencies to develop and implement plans to make scientific publications resulting from federally funded research publicly available within a year of publication.

July 2014: Department of Energy Public Access Plan approved and published

DOE's plan, in response to the OSTP memo, details the steps it will take to offer public access to scientific publications.

August 2014: DOE PAGES^{Beta} launched

The Department's portal provides public access to journal articles and accepted manuscripts resulting from DOE research funding.

October 2014: DOE public access requirement went into effect

DOE researchers must submit accepted manuscripts to the Office of Scientific and Technical Information.

Now: DOE PAGES provides users free access to the best available version of DOE-affiliated scholarly publications, either the version-of-record journal article or the corresponding accepted manuscript.

The Department of Energy Public Access Gateway for Energy and Science – DOE PAGES – is the search engine that makes scholarly scientific publications resulting from DOE research funding publicly accessible and searchable at no cost to users.
