As you know, the second meeting of the Laser Classification Panel has been scheduled for May 21, 1971. We are planning to have the meeting at the H Street office, however, there is a distinct possibility that the Commission may be in Germantown that day so that it may be necessary to move the meeting to Germantown. As soon as that is firm, I will let you know.

At the moment we have made no plans to have the Panel meet with anyone except the Commission. No briefers have so far been invited to attend. During the discussions on the second day of our first meeting, mention was made of the possibility of having some people from Los Alamos and Livermore, and also the possibility that we might invite Dr. Lukasik of ARPA, but no decision was made. If it is your feeling that some such individuals should be invited to meet with the Panel on the 21st of May, I would appreciate your letting me know as soon as you can so that the necessary arrangements for their attendance can be made. If I don't hear from you by April 15, I will assume that you do not feel that any additional briefing will be required.
