I would like to express on behalf of the Commission their appreciation for your consenting to serve as a member of the Ad Hoc Classification Panel on Laser Applications.

In the letter you received from Dr. Seaborg, mention was made of the desire to hold the first meeting during the first week in January. Unfortunately, due to prior commitments on the part of most of the Panel members, it has become necessary to delay the first meeting until the 4th and 5th of February 1971.

It is our plan to have a two-day meeting with the first day being devoted to briefings by representatives of the Department of Defense, the Central Intelligence Agency, Bell Laboratories, Livermore Laboratory, Los Alamos Scientific Laboratory, the Division of Research and the University of Rochester. The meeting is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m. on February 4 in Room 1062 at the H Street Office of the AEC, Washington, D.C. We look forward to seeing you at that time.
