RENEWAL OF RESEARCH PROJECT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, SAN DIEGO,
"PROBLEMS IN THE THEORY OF MANY-BODY SYSTEMS", UNDER KEITH A. BRUECKNER

At Information Meeting 1067 on October 14, 1970, the Commission, in noting the renewal of Professor Brueckner's AEC project, asked for information of his involvement on behalf of other Government agencies, especially his support by the Advanced Research Projects Agency (ARPA).*

In response to our request, ARPA has provided us with the following information:

"Dr. Brueckner has been involved in ARPA research programs for a number of years. The extent of Dr. Brueckner's involvement in ARPA supported programs under contracts at this time is listed below.

1. University of California, San Diego (Institute of Pure and Applied Physical Sciences), Contract No. DA31-124-AROD-257, ARPA Order No. 570. Under the proposed contract period November 1, 1970-October 31, 1971, Dr. Brueckner is participating in laser interactions and diagnostics at an annual salary rate of

2. KMS. Contract No. N00014-70-C-0274, ARPA Order No. 925, for the period April 1, 1970-March 31, 1971, in the role of technical director of SEESAW theoretical analysis and computation, 400 hours at \$20.00/hr., \$8,000.

3. IDA Consultant at \$200/day. He is reported as an IDA consultant under the ARPA/IDA contract. As such his consultant fee is funded from ARPA funds. An estimate of the amount of time he expects to devote to this activity should be obtained from IDA. For this purpose, I suggest you call Dr. Joel Bengston."


