Dear Dr. Noyes:

As you will recall, we exchanged letters during January of this year and discussed a study group to review radiological warfare.

Since that time, the Atomic Energy Commission has answered specific production questions bearing on the problem which were asked by the Military Liaison Committee. Also, the MLC has requested the Armed Forces Special Weapons Project to sponsor a study group to make a technical review of the field.

I would be particularly pleased if you will serve as chairman of this group. We intend to ask a representative of the Weapons Systems Evaluation Group to serve as a member so that the study will provide the maximum background for their investigation of the military worth question.

Should you find that you are able to act as chairman, members of my staff will contact you so that the details of the composition and method of operation of the group can be arranged to your satisfaction.
