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OLD TARGET S - This target was about 4 km south of the Aerial Spray Grid Tower.

PANSY BED - This grid was a part of the V-Grid complex and was just west of the present photo bunker.

* * RAD PAD - This designation applies to the unfinished concrete slab east of Camel Back Mountain which has had a variety of physical test facilities installed on it.

RIVER BED - The dry bed of the Sevier River, along which the Rising Sun Grid is constructed, was used as a convenient testing area when steep clay bluffs were required.

SALT FLATS - The Salt Flats impact points are specified when known. In some cases the only possible identification is the Salt Flats in general.

SALT FLATS IMPACT POINT - This designation refers to the impact end of the Granite Peak Range.

TARGET S - This target is also known as the Downwind Grid.

TOWER GRID HOLDING AREA - This area is about 3 km south of the Tower Grid.

TOWER GRID (Igloo 2 km south) - A steel, earth-covered building was constructed at this location for hazard tests.

VAT - This concrete tank was built east of the V-Grid Center for conduct of hazard classification tests.

V-GRID - When used alone, this designation is interpreted as the central target point on V-Grid.

WHITE SAGE FLATS - The general designation of the area south of Carr Facility, extending from Davis Mountain on the east and to Simpson Buttes on the west.

WIG MOUNTAIN - This designation is used to generally identify the area of a test conducted at a specially prepared site.

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
