



1. Reference (a) requested provisions be made to order volunteer reserve personnel to the Naval Aerospace Medical Research Laboratory for temporary active duty.

2. The importance of the BUMED effort to determine the biomedical effects of electromagnetic radiation is appreciated. However, even with the Bureau of Medicine and Surgery offer to provide funds to defray the costs of the temporary active duty, the MPN funds that would be required for subjects' basic pay and allowances are not available due to the severe budgetary constraints presently imposed. Therefore the request regretfully can not be approved.
