SUBJECT: The Secretary of Defense's Ad Hoc Committee on
Chemical, Biological, and Radiological Warfare

1. I have approved the Major Recommendations of the report of the Secretary of Defense's Ad Hoc Committee on Chemical, Biological, and Radiological Warfare, dated 30 June 1950, with the exception of Recommendation I (National Policy) and Recommendation VII (Radiological Warfare Evaluation), on which action is being deferred.

2. Action to carry out Recommendation II through VI and Recommendation VIII of the report will be undertaken by addressees of this memorandum within their respective fields of responsibility.

3. In view of the primary responsibility of the Department of the Army for research, development, and procurement in the field of chemical and biological warfare, I am asking the Secretary of the Army to coordinate the actions to implement Recommendations III through VI.
