SUBJECT: Nomination to FRC &amp; HEW Board of Editorial Advisors

1. In response to your phone call of 15 August 1967, I have carefully reviewed the credentials of members of the DASA and AFRRI staffs in order to recommend a suitable replacement for Col Mitchell on a Federal Radiation Council and the DOD representative on the Board of Advisors of HEW Publication, "Radiological Health Data Reports".

2. Based on my review, I recommend Dr. Harold O. Wyckoff, Deputy Director (Scientific), AFRRI, for filling both of these advisory positions subject to ~~his~~ <sup>your</sup> concurrence.

a. While Dr. Wyckoff is not particularly strong in radiobiology-  
per se, he has had extensive scientific research experience in nuclear physics, radiation protection and radiation measurements. He has earned an outstanding international reputation in these fields with many authoritative publications including authorship of a book on radiation protection.

b. Dr. Wyckoff is well versed in application of the scientific method of research.

c. He has had previous experience with the Federal Radiation Council, having served on FRC Working Groups.

d. His immediate supervisor at NBS was Dr. Lauriston S. Taylor,
