SUBJECT: Monthly Joint Medical Research Conference for July 1962

Our Conference Chairman, Dr. Richard A. Kern, has requested that the principal agenda item for the July 11, 1962, Joint Medical Research Conference be a consideration of the reestablishment of the former Advisory Panel on Medical Sciences, which was responsive to the Director of Defense Research and Engineering.

Accordingly, you are requested to be prepared to recommend a list of specialty fields in the biological and medical sciences which you consider the most important to be represented by membership on the proposed Panel. In addition, you should have in mind the names of outstanding civilian biological and medical scientists who might be candidates for membership. Your consideration of potential candidates can include civilian scientists in other federal agencies than the Department of Defense.

For your additional information, it is intended that the new Panel be responsible for scientific advice to the Director of Defense Research and Engineering in the broad fields of the biological and medical sciences with the exception of agent development for biological and chemical weapons.

The meeting will be held at 0900 in Room 3-D-835 on 11 July 1962, The Pentagon.
