When the form is used as a request for review, and the classification of the subject or title standing alone is unknown to the holder of the document, the symbol "?" will be placed in the column headed "Classification of Subject." When the form is used as a notification, the current classification of the document or title will be indicated on this column using the symbols shown in paragraph 3 above.
- 6. When a document has been reviewed and downgraded and the result of the review cannot be determined, the result of the review will be indicated by entering the symbol NOT DET in the column headed "Classification of Subject." The agency conducting the review may answer the request on the same form, using the symbols provided in paragraph 3 above.
