SUBJECT: CCTC Report "Q"

1. Reference is made to:

- a. CCTC Report "Q".
- b. OCCmLO GO Nr 35, 19 Aug 60.

2. OCCmLO GO Nr 35, 19 Aug 60, has established a new Class II activity to be known as Nuclear Defense Laboratories. This GO has also withdrawn Radiological Laboratory from CRDL.

3. These two actions have impact upon CCTC Report "Q" so as to necessitate the following changes in the CRDL Project Program submission:

a. Page Q3: Delete the reference to task 4C12-10-007-02 from "Nuclear Weapons Effects" to read "Atomic Weapons Testing".

b. Page Q39: Change the title of task 4C12-10-007-02 from "Nuclear Weapons Effects" to read "Atomic Weapons Testing".

c. Page Q39: Since the following projects and tasks are to be withdrawn from CRDL and conveyed to Nuclear Defense Labs, it is requested the identification letter be changed as indicated:

- (1) 4C12-10-007 to 4NL2-10-007
- (2) 4C12-10-007-02 to 4NL2-10-007-02
- (3) 4C12-10-007-03 to 4NL2-10-007-03
- (4) 4C12-10-007-04 to 4NL2-10-007-04
- (5) 4C12-10-007-05 to 4NL2-10-007-05
- (6) 4C12-10-007-06 to 4NL2-10-007-06
- (7) 4C12-10-007-07 to 4NL2-10-007-07

Establishment of U. S. Army Chemical Corps  
Nuclear Defense Laboratory

1. Effective 1 September 1960, the Radiological Laboratory of the U. S. Army Chemical Research and Development Laboratories, with its functions, equipment, personnel and records, is withdrawn from assignment to the Commander of the Chemical Research and Development Laboratories and established as the U. S. Army Chemical Corps Nuclear Defense Laboratory, a Class II activity of the Chemical Corps.
2. The U. S. Army Chemical Corps Nuclear Defense Laboratory is assigned to the Commander of the U. S. Army Chemical Corps Research and Development Command. It is located at Army Chemical Center and attached to that installation for administrative and logistical support.
3. TD Unit No. 03-1504-00 is assigned; initial personnel authorization, 5 officers, 32 enlisted and 52 civilian spaces.
4. Correspondence identification symbol CMLRD-ND is assigned.
