SUBJECT: Use of Volunteers in Research (U)

TO: Commanding Officer
U. S. Army Chemical Warfare Laboratories
Army Chemical Center, Maryland

1. (C) Approval has been granted by the Secretary of the Army for the conduct of research investigations using volunteers for studies in defense against non-lethal incapacitating chemical warfare agents. These experiments will conform to those already proposed by the laboratory and reviewed by The Surgeon General, U. S. Army. (EA 2148, EA 1176 and related compounds and the benzilates and related compounds)
2. (C) Additional authority was granted by the Secretary of the Army to pursue similar volunteer studies with other non-lethal incapacitating chemical warfare agents provided The Surgeon General, U. S. Army concurs with the protocol and procedures by the laboratory.
3. (U) Special care and attention will be taken to insure that any portion of these investigations, which is accomplished by contract, adheres to the same safeguards applicable to Department of the Army laboratories.
