1. In response to your undated memorandum, subject as above, a review of specified pages from certain annual histories of the U.S. Army Test and Evaluation Command (TECOM) was conducted. With one exception, all information was deemed UNCLASSIFIED. A copy of this information is enclosed.
2. Information on pages 115 and 116 of the 1 July 1965 - 30 June 1966 history has been excised inasmuch as it requires coordination with TECOM. Blackened areas identify the excisions. Following completion of our coordination, you will be immediately notified regarding the classification status of this information.
