1. Approval of the minutes of the eighth and ninth meetings.
2. Select date of next P.E meeting. During the latter part of June, the CCLE may ask Panel advice on specific planned FY '56 obligations.
3. Aircraft Nuclear Propulsion. Representatives of Convair will discuss their program with emphasis on those areas mentioned in the joint Panel advice to the Coordinating Committees.

The Panel will also consider the adequacy and timing of the proposed facilities at Pratt and Whitney. Dr. Murphree will comment on his trip to Pratt and Whitney on 22 April 1955 with the GAC, during which he also represented the P.E.

Those members of the Panel on Aeronautics who accompanied the PAE on the recent tour of ANP facilities have been invited to participate in the discussion.

4. Professor Hanson will present the report resulting from his group's study of Shock Simulation.
5. The Panel will discuss their trip to KAPL, and the present program for nuclear propulsion of submarines.
6. The ASD-R&D has requested the Panel to monitor the joint DOD-AEC investigation of the vulnerability of atomic weapons. An uncoordinated rough draft proposal of DOD participation has been prepared. AFSWP is engaged in coordinating this proposal within the DOD. The Panel will consider how it wishes to monitor the DOD-AEC program.
