1. The history for the PT&I Division for the quarter ending 31 December 1954 is herewith submitted.

2. The Intelligence Branch section of this report indicates in paragraph III-B-2 that the actual civilian strength of the branch was 16 employees at the close of this reporting period. This is in error as there was one OS-11 vacancy in the Counterintelligence Section.

3. The following are submitted as additional comments for the quarter ending 30 September 1954:

a. On 1 July 1954, the Executive Section of the PT&I Division was reorganized to provide for an Assistant Chief, replacing the former position of Deputy Chief. Mr. Delbert H. Flint, formerly assigned as Training Specialist in Training Branch, was appointed to this position.

b. Colonel Frank M. Arthur, Chief, PT&I Division, attended the Ninth Tripartite Conference held 13-25 September 1954 in England. He participated in the "Service Aspects" portion of the conference held at London and Porton.
