SUBJECT: Negotiation of Contract with University of Cincinnati College of Medicine



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1. The attached proposal is for continuation of a research program which the University of Cincinnati has been conducting on total and partial body irradiation studies for DASA since January 1960 under Contract Nos. DA-49-146-XZ-029 and XZ-315. The Contractor's performance under Contract No. DA-49-146-XZ-029 was rated as excellent and the same high standard was observed throughout Contract DA-49-146-XZ-315. As a result of the above research, the Contractor has become uniquely qualified to perform the proposed work. To seek competition for the proposed Contract No. DASA01-69-C-0131 would adversely affect the Project and seriously jeopardize the continuity of the research.
2. Negotiation will be conducted pursuant to 10 USC 2304(a)(5) and ASPR 3-205 which provides authority for negotiation with any university, college or other educational institution for experimental, developmental or research work, including services, test and reports necessary or incidental thereto.
3. The University of Cincinnati has submitted a cost estimate of \$70,000 for a Cost Reimbursement (CR), without fee, type of contract. This estimate, however, is subject to negotiation and all costs in connection with or incidental thereto will be analyzed prior to negotiation.
4. Negotiation will be undertaken upon approval of this procurement by the Director, DASA and commitment of sufficient funds to cover the cost of the proposed procurement.
