

DETERMINATION AND FINDINGS

Responsibility of Contractor

1. In connection with the proposed award to the University of Cincinnati, College of Medicine, Cincinnati, Ohio of Contract No. DASA01-69-C-0131, a Cost-Reimbursement R&D type contract for approximately \$71,369, for a study of radiation effects in man: manifestations and therapeutic efforts, I hereby find that:

a. The University of Cincinnati is a non-profit educational institution which has performed under various DASA-sponsored contracts, demonstrating its technical capability and financial responsibility. The Contractor's performance under Contract No. DA 49-146-XZ-029 was rated as excellent by the cognizant Contracting Officer's Representative and the same high standard was observed throughout performance under Contract No. DA 49-146-XZ-315.


b. No major difficulties have been encountered in the administration of the University of Cincinnati contracts.

c. The Contractor's name does not appear on the Joint Consolidated List of Debarred, Ineligible and Suspended Contracts, DASA Circular 470-2, 1 January 1969 as revised through 1 April 1969.

2. Based on the above information, I hereby determine that:

a. The Contractor is a responsible supplier within the standards set forth in ASPR 1-903.

b. Technical and financial pre-award surveys of the Contractor be waived for this procurement.
