<p>Understand you are taking exception to the stipulated salary support item in the Contract?</p>	<p>Yes. Our understanding is that it is not mandatory for use. None of our other contracts contain such an item.</p>
<p>Under ASPR it is mandatory. Let me read ASPR 15-302.7. (Quoted here ASPR, REV 3, 30 Jun 69) Can you tell me why are only now taking exception to this item since it was negotiated with Dr. Sanger at the time of the basic contract, salary rates were obtained from him and the categories listed were determined by him to be either a faculty member or professorial staff member. All other categories fall within the level-of-effort item.</p>	<p>That I cannot say. Except that it limits the personnel we can use.</p>
<p>This then becomes a question of whether they fall within the payroll distribution or not, for purposes of audit?</p>	<p>We keep payroll distribution records for all categories but the faculty. This is only part of the problem, in that we feel that if under stipulated salary support we would be subject audit for faculty members time.</p>

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<p>Your certification required when stipulated salary support is under your contract should cover you, and as long as the percentage of time is not exceeded that should be sufficient for the auditors.</p>	<p>O.K. What about the period of performance for the stipulated salary support, in particular the first period from 15 June 69 through 15 March 1970? This should be 14 June 1970 instead of 15 March 1970</p>
<p>Can you determine if research was on a continuing basis from 15 March 1970 through 14 June 1970?</p>	<p>Will check out</p>
<p>If so, then send me a letter so stating, and can amend the contract to cover. The percentage of time stated in the contract cannot, however, be exceeded. If you do, then you are in an overrun state</p>	<p>Will check out and write you letter regarding results and whether or not it will result in an overrun.</p>
