There were 51 black and 31 white patients treated. There were 62% black and 38% white patients. A review of 3068 cancer patients in Cincinnati General Hospital program from 1962 to 1970 indicates that 52% black patients. Fisher's test of exact probability indicates that the differences in these proportions are not statistically significant.
