Dr. Gall,

I have now spoken to all living adult patients in the Total Body Radiation Study, and have recorded these interviews. In addition the parents of two of the three children have contacted me.

All of them do not wish to talk to any Senate investigators. In my interviews with them I did not counsel them against such talks but told them they had a constitutional right to say anything they wished about us, or nothing. The interviews were witnessed.

All but one patient remembered that some of our research results could be used to help soldiers in the battlefield as well as civilian casualties.
