MEMORANDUM FOR PRINCIPAL DEPUTY ASSISTANT TO THE
SECRETARY OF DEFENSE FOR ATOMIC ENERGY

SUBJECT: Cincinnati Hearing

The Army Officer traveling to Cincinnati in support of your testimony to the Subcommittee on Administrative Law and Government Relations is Major Dale G. Vander Hamm, US Army Medical Service Corps.

Dale is the Chief of the Army's Medical Research and Development Command's Human Use Review and Regulatory Affairs Division. In simple terms, he is the Subject Matter Expert on the Federal, Department of Defense, and Army rules on human use. He makes certain COL Glenn does the right thing in the Review Board's deliberations. Dale is also the alternate member to (Navy) CAPT John Jemionek (DDR&E) to the Human Subject Research Subcommittee of the Federal Coordinating Committee for Science, Engineering and Technology. This Subcommittee is THE body that wrote, monitors and revises 45 CFR Part 46 (the HHS regulations for the Protection of Human Subjects). In short, he knows this stuff backwards and forwards, both from the standpoint of what we are supposed to do and what we are doing...and for the record, they are one and the same thing.
