

1. Investigation of the circumstances responsible for the alleged overexposure to film badge number 041 issued to "Personnel of General Dispensary" reveals that it was issued to a dispensary that serves the Headquarters of the Republic of Korea Army.

2. The dispensary takes about seven X-rays a day and the badge was issued by KMAG in an effort to assist in the training of personnel. Subsequent to the report of the overexposure the personnel have been given additional instruction in the care and handling of film badges including the necessity of issuing them to individuals by name.
