Dear Dr. Steger:

As you may recall from previous conversations and correspondence, the Department of Defense (DoD) Radiation Experiments Command Center (RECC) is the central repository for human radiation experiment information. This office is responsible for obtaining and maintaining all records related to DoD's human radiation experimentation. As such we have requested that institutions which had relevant contracts with DoD components submit all applicable information to this office. Attached is a copy of previous correspondence which requested the materials you have already provided to the RECC.

It has come to our attention that several boxes of information were submitted to the Advisory Committee on Human Radiation Experiments (ACHRE) during the Cincinnati field hearing in September 1994. At the present time, it is more important than ever that the RECC has a copy of all relevant documents. Our purpose in contacting you is to begin correlating the information provided to us versus what was provided to the ACHRE.

We would like to request an inventory of the material that you submitted to ACHRE at the Cincinnati hearing. If the documents were already sent to the RECC in your shipment of four boxes in April of 1994, please let us know. If any of the material submitted to the ACHRE was newly identified documents, please provide a copy to the RECC as soon as possible.
