
MEMORANDUM FOR DDR&E ADVISORY PANEL ON MEDICAL AND BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES

SUBJECT: First Meeting, 30 November - 1 December 1962

1. The scope of the Department of Defense program of research in the medical and biological sciences is sufficiently broad that it seemed advisable to present at the first meeting of the Advisory Panel a cross-section of several of the Service laboratories rather than a detailed picture of a single laboratory. With this in mind a program has been arranged so that:
 - a. The morning of the first day will be allotted to presentations by the host laboratory - the Air Force's Aerospace Medical Research Laboratories.
 - b. The afternoon of the first day will be split equally between the two non-host services, the Army and the Navy. Each will make presentations on two of their laboratories.
 - c. The morning of the second day will be devoted to the executive meeting of the Panel.
2. If this scheme proves satisfactory, it will be planned that at each subsequent meeting of the Panel a similar program will be arranged, so that a minimum of five laboratories will have their research activities reviewed at each meeting. This proposal is, of course, subject to Panel acceptance.
3. Billeting at the Wright-Patterson Visiting Officers Quarters has been arranged for all attendees at the Panel meeting. Those who have indicated the time of their arrival will be met by government automobile and taken to the VOQ.
4. Messing as a group has been arranged for the noon and evening meals of Friday. All other meals will be available at on-base facilities on an individual basis.
5. Administrative and secretarial assistance in connection with the business of the Panel will be provided. Transportation between quarters and meeting places has been arranged.
6. After the executive session on Saturday, transportation to departure points will be provided as required.
