I. GENERAL

The Advisory Panel on Medical Sciences is established to enlist the advice and judgment of the nation's scientific and engineering community in the planning and prosecution of the military research, development and engineering programs in Medical Sciences. The Panel will operate in accordance with DOD Instruction 5129.5, "Research and Engineering Advisory Panels."

II. MEMBERSHIP

The Assistant Secretary of Defense (Research and Engineering) shall appoint a chairman and members of the Panel from among civilian scientists, engineers and other experts.

III. FIELD OF INTEREST

The Panel on Medical Sciences shall provide technical advice, as required by the Department of Defense, on all research, development and engineering aspects of defense programs in the fields of aviation medicine, shipboard and submarine medicine, physiology, military and field medicine, psychiatry, atomic medicine, and other pertinent allied medical sciences.

IV. CANCELLATION

Reference (b) is superseded and cancelled.
