MEMORANDUM FOR ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF DEFENSE (ATOMIC ENERGY)

SUBJECT: Locating Records of DoD Human Radiation  
Experiments

1. Based on query response and personal interviews with current employees who have thorough knowledge of the history of the Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA), initial indications are that this Agency has not conducted nor participated in human radiation experiments.
2. A comprehensive review of the Agency's official disposition schedule and subsequent discussions revealed, however, that files from the record category "General Legal Reference Papers" contain copies of court testimony of a former DCA employee who was subpoenaed to testify as a hostile witness against the U.S. Government. This testimony did not involve any participation by DISA in human radiation experiments. This testimony was derived from the employee's previous employment with another Agency. It should be noted that these copies are duplicates of the "official record copies" of the documents under the purview of certain other government agencies.
