to the Executive Secretary for Board consideration on 15 December 1950. The Panel's section of this report must be completed at this meeting in order to have it available along with the other Panel reports for the late November meeting of the Committee on Medical Sciences. At that time, the Committee will integrate and consolidate all program guidance reports for FY 1953.

2. Attachment A outlines the purpose and method of preparing the Program Guidance Report for FY 1953. References (b) and (c) may be used as a guide for the preparation of the FY 1953 report. However, it will be noted that there is a substantial change in the method of preparation as outlined in Attachment A.

3. Attachment B represents the latest available information concerning the possible expansion of programs in FY 1951 and 1952 which may have a bearing on Program Guidance.

4. Reference (a) has not been distributed to Panel members, but will be available at the meeting. This document provides broad strategic guidance from a military point of view and can readily be incorporated in the Panel's report without prior preparation on the part of Panel members. The Executive Director will briefly outline this requirement at the meeting.

5. Although the dollar sign is not the primary yardstick involved in formulating Program Guidance, it is necessary for reference purposes in evaluating program emphasis. Accordingly, it is recommended

that Panel members bring reference material (d) to the meeting. In addition the Executive Director will discuss Attachments D and E concerning supplemental allocations of FY 51 funds which have an impact on the various programs. Attachment D is reproduced as a possible aid in orientation, and the formulation of the program guidance.

6. At this time the Departments have not yet submitted their revised FY 1952 budgets to the RDB. It is anticipated that service representatives at the meeting will be prepared to brief the Panel on the Departments' supplemental budget submissions for FY 1951, and FY 1952.
