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

Dear Colonel Blount:

During our conversations concerning the work to be done at Ladd Field as an expedition for personnel in the States, no mention was made of the program to be carried out in the summer. Col. Bollerud has indicated that he is very much interested in having summer programs at the laboratory. These programs can well be worked out with botanists and zoologists who could go to Ladd Field and work on ecological problems. We have already arranged for one interested party from the University of Illinois to write up a program for summer work, in which he would be collecting specimens and making physiological studies on various animals in comparison with other animals he has studied in the temperate climates, as well as the hotter climates. I would appreciate your comments on our subsidizing programs in the summer, as well as in the winter.
