

I have called Mr. Art LaPort to determine if he has any information. I have not received a call back to date.

* All records inactive prior to 1972 have been destroyed through the procedure utilized by this facility. The only hope for retrieving any information is if someone can produce the list of patients. We will generally search the files to pull any records on active patients that are on the list.
