

Received request for 10 to 15 photographs for picture story on UC School of Medicine's research with whole-body radiation from ANI (Authenticated News International). Request forwarded to Dr. Gall.

Request from Dr. Edmund Casey, president elect of National Medical Assn., for the list of publications from the radiation study, was met; JA sent Dr. Casey the list provided by Dr. Gall. (Dr. Casey told JA he had been asked for statements on behalf of the NMA reaction but he did not know about the work. All he wanted was the list of publications so that he could read them.)

George Alexander of the Radioisotope Lab said a call had been taken there today from a Sandra Lawson who identified herself as a UC student, who did not want to talk to a physician but a technician, just to satisfy her own mind about the radiation program. She would not give her telephone number, but will call back 10/20. (Mr. Alexander tried to establish her identify but said UC had no record of such a student in the registrar's office).

JA called Dr. Gall who said in thistime of crisis to refer all such calls to him, even the individuals like Miss Lawson asking for information. Mr. Alexander was told this.
