1. On 22 October 1959, the Health Physics Office, these Laboratories, received a telegram from Lexington Signal Depot that a film badge worn by SP₄ Kenneth H. Kary, US 55 622 217, was exposed to an ionizing radiation dose of 2500 millirems. This exposure occurred during the period of 8 October through 14 October 1959.
