1. DA Message PM256100 April (copy inclosed) indicates that John C. Goshorn, Jr. and Ralph K. Rowland, of your command received a dose of ionizing radiation considerable in excess to total body radiation permissible. Should such incidents be frequently recurring, serious impairment of the health of the individual could result.

2. It is recommended that a review of your X-ray facilities be initiated as soon as possible. Should technical difficulties arise, the radiation and health physicists at the U. S. Army Environmental Health Laboratory are available to provide assistance upon written request to The Surgeon General, Department of the Army, Washington 25, D.C., ATTN: NRDCR-OH
