The attached correspondence from David Grant USAF Medical Center requesting an amendment to AF Permit No. 2-0008 (I75) to authorize Potassium-43 for myocardial imaging is submitted for your review. The correspondence indicates that this will be a continuation of a study approved by the Office of the Surgeon General on 22 March 1972.

The USAF Radioisotope Committee does not have any records pertaining to the application and approval for the original study other than Hq USAF/SGPAAP indorsement returning the application to MAC/SGPE without action (copy attached). Apparently a subsequent application was approved and returned directly to David Grant USAF Medical Center. The Committee was not informed of this action and no USAF Radioactive Material Permit was issued.
3. The USAF Radioisotope Committee requests that this correspondence be returned to this office, pursuant to your review and approval, so that a USAF Radioactive Material Permit may be issued in accordance with AFR 160-57 and AFR 160-124.
