1. In ¹¹¹I-DTPA is used to establish the diagnosis of low pressure hydrocephalus, to document the presence of arachnoid blocks, cysts and for the analysis of ventricular shunt patency. The study has been used in these selected cases, where its clinical application has proven very helpful. This clinical investigation project is being terminated under the present primary investigator but will probably be reinitiated by Lt Col Gary Hinzman when he becomes Chairman of the Department of Nuclear Medicine on 1 July 1977.
2. No special funds were allotted for this study.
