Colonel Meng stated that the purpose of the meeting was to review the informed consent for Diane Owens' radioactive copper isotope administration. A radioactive isotope of copper study is proposed to be done during a required surgical procedure. Lt Col Rundell explained the case history and the protocol for the isotope administration to be followed during the portal shunt operation. See attached SGH letter, April 1979 (attachment one) and article, "Radiocopper in Diagnosing Liver Disease," (attachment two). The committee approved the informed consent (attachment three) with the addition of the following sentence to be inserted after the first sentence in the second paragraph:

This is an experimental procedure since radioactive copper has not been generally accepted as a diagnostic or therapeutic drug.

Approval for administration of radioactive isotope of copper has been obtained from the Food and Drug Administration, Nuclear Regulatory Commission, USAF Med Cen Wright-Patterson Isotope Committee, USAF Med Cen Wright-Patterson Institutional Review Committee and HQ AFMSC/SGP. Participation is on a voluntary basis.
