Abstract: *Summary: An anthropometric survey of the hand combining both direct and x-ray measurements was conducted to establish a glove sizing program. X-rays of both left and right hands were taken on a sample of 411 male personnel (Air Force 91%, civilian 9%) from Wright Patterson and Lockbourn Air Force Bases. All exposures were made at 50 KVP and 40 MA for .25 seconds with a tube to film distance of 38.75 inches. Extensive measurements were taken from the films and directly to create the data base.
