The attached documents (Atch 1) are forwarded to the ACHRE as part of their request for Pre-1975 studies performed under AF Contract. The subject study was performed in Paris, France under the auspices of the European Office of Aerospace Research during the 1964-1968 time frame. This study, which involved whole-body irradiation of leukemia patients, was discovered during our review of School of Aerospace Medicine Records contained at the Suitland National Records Center (Box 71A-458). We have added this study to our original database as study No. 107 (Atch 2); **this number should be used when forwarding these documents to the ACHRE.** For our own internal records we have assigned Document No. 425 to this set of documents; **this number should be used when you return the original set to us.** Because of the large number of individual documents in this set it is more convenient to assign a single number.
