Listed below is the information furnished in response to your letter dated 1 May 72.

- a. C-5 (70): "Hormonal and Epidemiological Studies in Women with Carcinoma of the Breast"

Investigation progress: The progress on this all inclusive study has been outstanding. At the present time we have accepted approximately 250 women for study. Followups on these women have been excellent. Data is being collated at the Biostatistical Center for the National Cancer Institute. In addition, peripheral information is being collected and contact has been made with the Biometrics Division at AMD for further evaluation.

A gross estimate would be that the project is 50% completed. It probably will extend over a period of about 3 additional years.

Special or unexpected problems: None.

Significant deviations from approved protocol: None.

Publications related to this work: None.

Presentations: Consultant hospitals have been updated on the progress and findings of the study to date.

Manhours expended in support: 9416, approx. 20 hrs/wk on-duty time and 4 hrs/wk off-duty time.
