

Since the departure of Col Robert Haff there has been no new Principal Investigator assigned for the protocols, subject above.

It is a requirement of AFM 169-6 that upon departure of the Principal Investigator of an active clinical investigation a new Principal Investigator be appointed. Would you please see that this is done and notify this office in writing. We will then forward this information to the Surgeon General's Office.

In protocol S-56, subject above, the last sentence of the technical approach states that at the end of a six month period of time the animals will be sacrificed, at which time a femoral venogram and portal venogram will be obtained to demonstrate patency of the renal anastomoses and development of collaterals. We plan to do this on 18 Jan78, unless you have some objection. Please let us know.
