Abstract: From Aug 1972 to Feb 1973 researchers at Wilford Hall Medical Center, Lackland AFB, TX, studied splenic function in patients with proven malignancy. 25 subjects with splenic cancer were studied. Subjects consented to technetium ^{99m} sulfur colloid scans with internal gamma doses enumerated as: liver 300 millirads, spleen 150 millirads and bone marrow 30 millirads. No differences in the scans of normal versus "hot" scan patients were reported.
