Abstract: From March 14, 1972 to May 20, 1974 researchers at Wilford Hall Medical Center, Lackland AFB, TX, studied the levels of thyroid hormone and TSH in normal pregnant women and their newborns and the effectiveness of oral thyroid hormone to suppress maternal and neonatal TSH. 22 subjects were studied. There was no radiation exposure to humans. The researchers concluded that synthroid did not cross the placental barrier
