3. Old business: None.

4. New business:

a. The following protocols were presented:

(1) F-98, "Treatment of Pelvic Endometriosis," Principal Investigator, Lt Col James Murray. Dr Murray presented his protocol. It was recommended that Dr Murray clarify the treatment regimens due to confusion with the schemas. The committee unanimously approved this study.

(2) I-193, "Protein and Steroid Hormones in Prostatic Neoplasia," Principal Investigator, Lt Col Donald E. Novicki. Dr Novicki presented his protocol and answered questions. The committee unanimously approved this protocol with the request that Dr Novicki obtain a letter from Pathology assuring that they are aware of the samples being sent to Southwest Research.

(3) S-69, "Optimum Number to Transbronchoscopic Lung Biopsies in the Diagnosis of Sarcoidosis and the Optimum Lobar Biopsy Location in Those Patients with Either Diffuse Disease or no Evidence of Parenchymal Disease," Principal Investigator, Maj Phillip Dellinger. Dr Dellinger was unable to present this protocol. OPEN ITEM.

b. The following semi-annual progress reports were reviewed and accepted:

(1) I-171, "Establishment of an Insulin Receptor Assay," Principal Investigator, Maj Timothy Looney.

(2) I-135, "Clinical Comparison of the Intramuscular Use of Chlorpromazine, Droperidol and Haloperidol in the Acutely Agitated Patient," Principal Investigator, Maj Frank Carpenter.

(3) I-175, "Post Myocardial Infarction Trial," Principal Investigator, Maj Gordon Haycraft.

(4) I-168, "Non-Allergic Rhinitis with Eosinophilia (NARES Syndrome)," Principal Investigator, Lt Col Robert Jacobs.

(5) I-148, "The Radioimmunoassay of Serum Androgens: Testosterone, Androstenedione, and Dihydroepiandrosterone (DHA)," Principal Investigator, Lt Col Villar Howard.

c. The following final report was presented and accepted: D-22, "Feasibility of N₂O - O₂ Sedalgia in Operational USAF Dental Clinics," Principal Investigator, Maj Ronald Miller. It was the decision of the committee that Dr Miller be commended for the thorough and professional job he did on this report.

d. Letters of Certification from the following divisions for the month of Jan 1980 were reviewed and accepted: SGHP, SGHR, and SGHS. No letter was received from SGHM for this period.

e. Dr Van Riper stated that the Inspector General had made a comment during last year's inspection that very little information from these studies ever gets into print. He had contacted Brooks with a request that they publish some of the results but he was turned down. Dr Van Riper went on to say that Brooke Army Medical Center is publishing a pamphlet entitled, "Progress Notes." For those doctors who are unaware of this publication it may be a possible way of getting some of our material published.
