3. New Business: The following protocol was reviewed and explained:

Title: "Tc-Phosphate Complexes in the Radioisotopic Diagnosis of Avascular Necrosis"

Primary Investigator: Ellis P. Couch, Maj, USAF, MC

Action: Approved

It is emphasized to the investigator that this protocol falls into Category II of the "Declaration of Helsinki," Clinical Research Combined with Patient Care. The standardized format for "informed consent" is adequate and may be used for the requirement stipulated for recorded informed consent." Dr. Brunstetter stated that he was informed by the investigator that this procedure would be used on adults only. The Committee agreed that it would be the responsibility of the investigator to insure or ascertain that women in the child-bearing age are not pregnant. Additionally, this procedure will not be used on children. A child is legally defined

as that individual less than 18 years of age.
